CCG Advisory Board Meeting, London	To understand the impact of the launch of new strengths of readily available and widely used levothyroxine will have on a Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) medicine optimisation programme, AMCo organised this advisory board. It was facilitated by Pharmacy Management and AMCo paid advisors the fees for attendance (6 medicines optimisation lead pharmacists within the CCGs, 2 GP practice medicines management/optimisation pharmacists and 2 pharmacists from Commissioning Support Units England).	£6500
Nicardipine Advisory Board Meeting, Manchester	To understand the prescribing trends for hypertensive crisis in the UK a half-day advisory board meeting with key anaesthetists, critical care and cardiothoracic consultants from across England was conducted. AMCo paid honoraria to 6 consultants who attended this advisory board.	£3000

Stock of levothyroxine tablets towards ThyraMI	AMCo provided stock of Eltroxin 25 and 50mcg tablets for a trial lead by Dr Salman Razvi; Prof Simon Pearce and Dr Azfar Zaman from Gateshead Health Foundation NHS Trust called <i>ThyraMI</i> . AMCo had no input into the protocol development or study execution and only supplied the stock. A total of 1527 packs of Levothyroxine 25microgram tablets and 960 packs of Levothyroxine 50 microgram tablets were provided to Gateshead Health Foundation NHS Trust to support the study. The commercial stock was valued at £ 6197.34.
